Organize a Middle School Dual in the Central Region!

Last year our region held several Middle School Duals prior to High School Duals at various schools in the area. Most of the wrestlers were in the 7th and 8th grade with a few exceptions. This summer we discussed doing this again but decided that is would be best for club representatives to organize a MS Dual at the high school near them. Teams were made up of those wrestlers that showed up and divided as equally as possible by weight to try and fill a roster.

For some, this was the only competition they had since they didn't participate in any sanctioned tournaments.

Check with your high school coaches to find out their schedule and ask if a MS Dual can be held prior to their varsity competition. These are generally during the week so it is important to try and get in contact with the youth clubs in your area or those that are willing to travel during the week for this event.

Last year, the dual between Bowie HS and rivals

Westlake proved to be an exciting experience for the youth wrestlers. Each wrestler taking center stage and competing while their fellow classmates cheered in the stands chanting back and forth was something not usually seen at a local youth tournament.
